

Arthur Fleischer, Jr. Biography

Arthur Fleischer, Jr. is the Senior Partner of Fried, Frank, Harris, Shriver & Jacobson, resident in the New York Office. He joined the firm in 1958, became a partner in 1967 and was the Co-Chairman from 1989 to 1997. Mr. Fleischer practices in the area of mergers and acquisitions.

Mr. Fleischer is co-author of Takeover Defense (Aspen Law & Business, 6th edition) and the author of numerous articles on securities regulation. He is co-author, along with Professor Geoffrey C. Hazard, Jr. and Miriam Z. Klipper, of Board Games (1988). He was a member of the Board of Governors of The American Stock Exchange from 1977 to 1983 and of the Legal Advisory Committee to the Board of Governors of The New York Stock Exchange.

Mr. Fleischer is a member of the Board of Trustees of the Whitney Museum of American Art, was formerly a member of the Board of Haleakala (d/b/a The Kitchen) and was formerly a Trustee of the Independent Curators International.
