

GERSON A. ZWEIFACH

Mr. Zweifach graduated from Yale Law School in 1979, where he was Note Editor of the Yale Law Journal. Mr. Zweifach clerked for Judge Pierre Leval of the United States District Court for the Southern District of New York and for Judge David Bazelon of the United States Court of Appeals for the District of Columbia Circuit.

In 1981, Mr. Zweifach began private practice with Williams & Connolly in Washington, D.C., specializing in complex civil litigation. Mr. Zweifach represented plaintiffs and defendants in a variety of securities, antitrust, and intellectual property matters, with a primary emphasis on trial work. Mr. Zweifach's matters included the representation of Richard A. Grasso in *Spitzer v. Grasso* in the New York state courts, as well as the representation of Medimmune in its challenge to Genentech's Cabilly patent in federal court in Los Angeles. He was listed in the *Lawdragon 500* (2007-2013).

In February 2012, Mr. Zweifach was named Senior Executive Vice President and Group General Counsel of News Corporation. With the separation of News Corporation from 21st Century Fox, Mr. Zweifach became General Counsel and Chief Compliance Officer of News Corporation and Group General Counsel and Chief Compliance Officer of 21st Century Fox Corporation.
