

Mr. Engles, age 57, graduated from Yale Law School in 1982. From 1982 to 1983 Mr. Engles clerked for Judge Anthony Kennedy in the 9th Circuit, following which he joined a small private investment company in Dallas, Texas. Mr. Engles purchased his first consumer packaged food company, Reddy Ice, in a private equity transaction in 1988. In 1994 he founded Suiza Foods Company, a vehicle formed to consolidate the U.S. milk processing industry. Mr. Engles took the company public in 1996.

In 2002 Suiza Foods acquired Dean Foods, a public company, and assumed its name. In 2005 Dean Foods distributed Treehouse Foods, a subsidiary, to its shareholders in a tax free spinoff. Treehouse remains a public company. In 2013 Dean Foods similarly distributed WhiteWave Foods, of which Mr. Engles is currently Chairman and CEO, to its shareholders in a tax free distribution. In addition to his role at WhiteWave, Mr. Engles serves on the board of trustees of Dartmouth College, and on the board of directors of the Grocery Manufacturers of America. He previously served as a director and as Chairman of the Board of Dean Foods and on the board of directors of Treehouse Foods, Inc.
