Carrie Bloss joined Breaking Ground in 2005. She also oversees Breaking Ground's new business venture providing leasing services to for-profit real estate developers. Ms. Bloss serves in advisory capacity providing recommendations to key leaders on policy initiatives and priorities through various committees including the NYC Continuum of Care, the 2015 CSH Statewide Supportive Housing Needs Assessment, and the Mayor's Supportive Housing Taskforce.

Prior to Breaking Ground, Ms. Bloss worked at the New York City Department of Homeless Services, first as a Senior Policy Analyst where she focused on management evaluation, and later as the Special Assistant to the Deputy Commissioner for Adult Services. Ms. Bloss previously served on the Board of Directors of NY Therapeutic Communities which provides drug treatment in the criminal justice setting.
