**Lisa H. Miller** serves as the Deputy Assistant Attorney General (DAAG) for the U.S. Department of Justice's Criminal Division with responsibility for overseeing the more than 200 prosecutors working in the Fraud Section and the Appellate Section, including the Sections' most significant prosecutions and policy issues. She was also a member of the Deputy Attorney General's Corporate Crime Advisory Group. Prior to her current appointment, Ms. Miller served as the Chief of the Market Integrity & Major Frauds Unit within the Fraud Section, supervising 45 prosecutors as they conducted investigations and prosecutions of varied matters across the country, from commodities fraud and spoofing to securities and investment fraud schemes. She also previously served as the Principal Assistant Chief of the Fraud Section's Health Care Fraud Unit; as a Trial Attorney in the Fraud Section; and as an Assistant United States Attorney for the Southern District of Florida. She has tried more than a dozen federal criminal jury trials and argued and briefed cases before the 11th Circuit Court of Appeals. Before becoming a federal prosecutor, she clerked for the Hon. Edgardo Ramos on the U.S. District Court for the Southern District of New York and worked as a litigation associate at Mayer Brown LLP.
